Relationship Question Checklist

These are some suggested questions of things you might want to find out or ask each other at different stages of your relationship.

Friendship

- 1. Do they have a relationship with God?
- 2. What are their hobbies and interests?
- 3. Who are their friends?
- 4. How do they relate to same-sex friends?
- 5. Do they have appropriate opposite-sex friendships?
- 6. Do they seek and follow advice?
- 7. What do you observe them doing in the community?
- 8. Where and how do they serve?
- 9. Are they leaders in the community and do they set a good example?
- 10. How do they prioritize their life? (Compare words & actions).

Going on dates

- 1. Do they have strong spiritual convictions and if so what are they?
- 2. If you've decided you are not dating exclusively, then are they actually going on dates with other people?
- 3. Do your know their sense of humor? Do you enjoy it?
- 4. Are they open-minded in their choice of who to ask out?
- 5. Do they try to serve and make others feel special on dates?
- 6. What is their attitude about going on dates?
- 7. Would they be ready to be married soon, 1-2 years? If not, what purpose will the relationship have?
- 8. Have you seen this person make and keep commitments to practice for bigger commitments later in life? (FOCUS, Corefa, etc., showing up consistently and early to things)
- 9. Are they responsible with possessions and money?
- 11. Has this person been a committed disciple for at least a year?
- 12. Do they make good choices with respect to future, health, etc?
- 13. Are you attracted to them? (Physically, emotionally, intellectually, spiritually).
- 14. What kind of community do they want to be involved in after college?

Dating exclusively- early

- 1. Do they want to have kids?
- 2. Where do they see themself serving long-term?
- 3. What fears do they have?
- 4. How do they make big decisions?
- 5. What gives them joy/what drains it?
- 6. What do they find relaxing?
- 7. Who are their best friends and why are they friends?
- 8. What makes them angry?

- 9. What makes them feel appreciated?
- 10. Are they proactive about making and keeping boundaries?
- 11. Do they ignore commitments because of dating relationships?
- 12. Have they lost friends because of a dating relationship?
- 13. Does your relationship grow you closer to God or further away?
- 14. Do we have common interests / things we can do together?
- 15. How do they handle the exclusivity of a relationship?
- 16. Do they have the same general goals you do in life?
- 17. Is this person opening up to people around them and mentor figures and asking for advice?

Dating exclusively- deciding if it's something worth pursuing

- 5. What is their relationship like with their sibling(s)?

- 10. Can they balance life (i.e. job, friends, money, responsibilities)?
- 11. What are their job prospects/spending habits?
- 12. Do they do a good job of maintaining same sex friendships during this time?

- 14. How does the person relate to their opposite sex parent?
- 15. Have you, as a pair, done a good job of keeping boundaries?
- 16. Is this person being active in their pursuit of godly things (i.e. service of community, spiritual life, personal growth)?
- 17. Does this person encourage you to pursue your ministry and time commitments (time with other same sex friends, studies, and social things) or are they jealous of your time?
- 18. What personality defects or shortcomings do they possess (i.e. anger, jealousy, drama)?

- 21. What do I think of their family? How do I get along with them? What does my family think of them?
- 22. Are we a greater force for the Kingdom together or separate?
- 23. Do they want pets? What kinds?
- 24. Could I handle being with them every day?

Dating exclusively- pre engagement

- 1. Are they open to pre-engagement counseling?
- 2. Are they good at managing increased boundaries in the relationship?
- 3. What are their views on using credit?
- 4. Do they have debt? How much?
- 5. Are they still open to mentors? Are you accountable to same-sex mentors and friends about your boundaries?
- 6. Are they teachable about how to relate to you
- 7. Where would they like to go to church?
- 8. What kind of sexual history do they have?
- 9. Do they have any illnesses/medical issues?
- 10. What is their definition of cheating in a relationship?
- 11. Can you picture yourself in their family?
- 12. Where do they want to spend holidays?
- 13. What do they think that gender roles look like in marriage?
- 14. What do they see as their roles in the marriage?
- 15. When would they like to have children? Do they want to adopt?
- 16. What are their thoughts on stay-at-home parenting versus working full-time?
- 17. Do I love them?
- 18. Can I imagine living without them? Can I imagine living with them?
- 19. Are they adept communicators?

Formal engagement
